
Some steps already proposed to help ensure a memorable, positive event are:


- One day prior to the event, testing and arranging the lights in a way that would adequately light the field of play and path from Montgomery Avenue to the stadium while being least disruptive to those neighboring the field.
- Approach the event like a standard weekend evening function which includes having increased police and security presence, a zero tolerance expectation for alcohol (the school has administrators present with breathalyzers), and supports in place to clean the premises immediately following the event.
- Appropriately staff the parking lots and bordering streets to ensure that guests park in designated areas.
- Engaging our parent booster and student council members in taking proactive steps, as well as being present and about the facility, to make sure that the conduct of attendees is neighborly.

Please note that the event on September 20th is not part of an effort to install permanent lighting on Arnold Field, but an effort to support the student-athletes who participate in one of the oldest and most storied athletic programs in the region. This same activity was held in the Fall of 2007 and was successful in joining the community together in support of the football program.
